Our topic this month is staff photo organization. Or to put it another way, “who takes the pictures, organizes the pictures and fixes the pictures on your yearbook staff.” We got this great advice on organizing your yearbook staff to take, organize and fix pictures. We loved and wanted to pass it on to all of you. We hope it helps those who are having a hard time with this problem.

- “Each student is responsible for getting his or her own pictures. However, if I go to an event or another student does, then we help each other out by taking pictures for them.
- You can never get enough pictures. I make this part of their grade so if they don’t take pictures, or they don’t get enough, then their grade gets docked. Usually, though, I try to help them out because I understand that students can’t always get to events that happen only once during the year.
- We haven’t had a problem yet, and the students generally take plenty of pictures without being reminded. This system is working for us.
- They then are also in charge of editing their own pictures and placing them on pages. Because of the very busy schedules of all of my students, it would be impossible to expect one person to get to every single event if we have only one staffer who is a designated photographer.”
